

Survey Says Results of 2015 Survey



■ Full-time
■ Part-time



- ➤ The vast majority of us are fulltime employees 93% (up from 90% in 2014)
 - ➤ 12 months contracts 88% 93% are salaried




- ➤ Salaries range \$10,000 over \$90,000/year Most selected category's:
 - >\$40-\$45,000/year 20%
 - >\$45-\$50,000/year 18%

Answered: 235 Skipped: 7




Most of us work at schools that have had regional positions for less than 5-9 years



How long has your school had regional admission positions in your current location?






49% are working in territories that have had a regional for less than 4 years.

Answered: 235 Skipped: 7




- > 12% of us are the only regional employed by our school

13 % have been Regionals for over 10 years




- ➤ We are virtually all linked to our campus databases, with Hobsons and Slate leading the charge in this arena

- ➤ 63% read electronically (4% Paper)

Answered: 228 Skipped: 14




61% of us review applications (up 3% from last year)26% review more than 500 apps.




- > 19% of us have supervisory roles in our offices
- > 56% Have a dedicated support person working with us
- > 86% participate in weekly/regular staff meetings
- >66 % visit campus 1-6 times a year/ 26% more that 9 times
- ➤Only 19% have supervisors that are also Regionals






Are you given an operating budget?






When you travel away from your locale (overnight), how does your school handle meal expenses?



99% of regionals receive compensation for meals when staying overnight.




When you travel locally (not overnight), how does your school handle meal expenses?






Are you reimbursed for hotel stays or do you receive per diem?

51% of regionals are asked to keep hotel at a "reasonable" rate. **28%** use a set state rate.



- ➤ 44% of Regionals Surveyed work for their Alma Mater (Up from 37% a year ago)
- > 49 % Serve on or chair a national or regional ACAC committee (up 5 % from a year ago)
- > 98% Surveyed can connect to campus data base
- > 53% have or are completing Masters (12% in progress)

Survey Says – Fun Facts



- ➤ 35 have unlimited vacation days
- ➤ 66% have been in admissions more than 4-years (down 4 %) this has some serious implications for future discussion amongst deans and directors
- ➤ Many of us feel extremely fortunate to work in our regional positions, we often struggle with work/life balance
- ➤ Vast majority extremely grateful for regional groups
