
The vast majority of us are fulltime – **95%** 93% in 2015 90% in 2014

59% of Regionals have a 12 month contract 14% of Regionals have a 9-11 month contract









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
How long has your school had regional admission positions in your current location?



Q15 How long have you served as an area representative?










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Q16 How long have you been involved in college admissions?








60% of us review applications (Down 1% from last year)



- ≻Only 19% have supervisors that are also Regionals






Q28 When you travel locally (no overnight), how does your school handle meal expenses?


When you travel locally (not overnight), how does your school handle meal expenses?



61% of regionals receive compensation for meals when traveling, but not staying overnight.




Q30 Are you reimbursed for hotel stays or per diem?





Q29 When you travel away from your locale (overnight), how does your school handle meal expenses?





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


Q30 Are you reimbursed for hotel stays or per diem?





Are you reimbursed for hotel stays or do you receive per diem?














Are you restricted to what kind of hotel you may use?






51% of regionals are asked to keep hotel at a "reasonable" rate. 28% use a set state rate.

- 38% of Regionals Surveyed work for their Alma Mater (Down from 45% a year ago)
- 45 % Serve on or chair a national or regional ACAC committee (49% last year)
- >64% have been regionals for less than 4 years.
- > 98% Surveyed can connect to campus data base
- 60% have or are completing Masters (12% in progress)
 (Up 7% from last survey)



- 44% of Regionals Surveyed work for their Alma Mater (Up from 37% a year ago)
- ➢ 49 % Serve on or chair a national or regional ACAC committee (up 5 % from a year ago)
- > 98% Surveyed can connect to campus data base
- > 53% have or are completing Masters (12% in progress)



35 have unlimited vacation days

- ➤66% have been in admissions more than 4-years (down 4 %) this has some serious implications for future discussion amongst deans and directors
- Many of us feel extremely fortunate to work in our regional positions, we often struggle with work/life balance
- ➢Vast majority extremely grateful for regional groups

- > 89% attend regular meetings weekly
- 78% attend retreats
- > 19% Have Supervisory Roles
 - 54% Supervise Regionals
 - 10% on campus staff
- ➢ 56% have dedicated campus support
- 73% supervised by Non regionals
- Only 38% bosses visit in territory.
