#### RUN

If given the opportunity to get out.....

#### GET OUT!!!!!!!

- Where is the shooter?
- Run away from the sound, putting distance between you and shooter
- Closest Exit away from shooter?
- Take phone if possible
- Get as far away as you can

#### HIDE

Where/How do I

Hide

- Lock the doors
- Barricade the doors
- Hide behind solid objects
- Turn off the Lights
- Stay Quiet
- Prepare yourself to Run/Fight

#### **FIGHT**

#### How do I fight an Active Shooter

- Mindset that you will make it!
- Arm yourself with something available
- Rally the people around you to fight
- Commit to the fight
- Incapacitate the active shooter
- Be willing to take over the weapon

#### When Law Enforcement Arrives

- Remain calm and follow Officers instructions
- Immediately raise hands above your head

#### What Else Can I Do?

Prepare

Don't be caught off guard

- Become aware of my surroundings
- Discuss situations with co-workers
- If I am in my classroom how would we get out
- Commons, Library, gym, playground, hallways, etc.

#### Don't Share Everything

- Don't share exact plans of where you plan to go with students prior to.
  - If an active shooter knows your plan, they will plan for it!
    - Secondary devices
    - Additional shooters

#### Networking

- Develop good working relationship with students.
  - Students that trust you, feel comfortable telling you subtle things they hear or see.

#### Safe Environment Team

- MS and US kids that may be eager to meet monthly to discuss safety in school.
  - Active Shooter
  - Social Media
  - See Something, Say Something
  - How to report what you hear, etc.
