
Salary and Cost of Living Results (Only Regions/Groups with More than 10 Respondents Included)






Average Salary by Rep Metro Area









Average Salary by Years as Regional Middle 50% and Range

















Average Salary by Age






Average Salary by Institution Size – 2019 vs 2022




Average Salary by Approximate Job Title – 2019 vs 2022




Average Salary by Job Title Middle 50% and Range










Average Salary by Number of Applications Read

What is a Cost of Living Index









A Cost of Living Index estimates the cost for basic necessities such as housing, food, transportation, taxes, healthcare, and other items CoL data comes from the

sets


CoL differences estimate the cost differences to <u>maintain</u> the same standard of living




